### SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND CONSTRUCTION OF 33 kV AND 11kV LINES

(information as per provision of ITB 43.2)

#### 1.1 Introduction

The Technical Bids were opened on 25 October 2011 at the Planning and Technical Services Department by the Bid Opening Committee in the presence of representatives of bidders. Each bidder's name and the presence or absence of the requisite bid security and its amount were announced and recorded. The Record of Bid Opening was prepared soon after the bids were announced and a copy of the Record of Bid Opening was furnished to the ADB by the Project on the same day. Following four Bidders submitted the bids:

Bidder No.1: Narendra-GET Power Joint Venture, Gongbu, Kathmandu

Bidder No. 2 AIPL\_SCCPL Joint Venture, Sunakothi, Lalipur, Nepal

Bidder No. 3: ZIEC-Tripureshwor-Janamukhi Joint Venture, Tripureshwor, Kathmandu

Bidder No. 4: Transglobal Power Limited, Bangalore, India

- a) The technical proposals submitted by the following two (2) bidders were considered responsive to the requirements of the bidding documents.
  - (i) Bidder No. 3: ZIEC-Tripureshwor-Janamukhi Joint Venture, Tripureshwor, Kathmandu
  - (ii) Bidder No. 4: Transglobal Power Limited, Bangalore, India
- (b) **Bidder No.1**: Narendra-GET Power Joint Venture, Gongbu, Kathmandu and **Bidder No. 2** AIPL\_SCCPL Joint Venture, Sunakothi, Lalipur, Nepal were considered not responsive as they did not have the minimum requirements stipulated in the bidding documents; their price proposals were to be returned unopened.

The ADB approved the above recommendation under cover letter dated 8 February 2012. The envelopes containing the price proposals of Bidder No. 1 and Bidder No.2 were returned on the same day, the two bidders, Bidder No. 3 and Bidder No. 4 were informed in writing that their technical proposals had been considered responsive to the requirements of the bidding documents and were invited to attend the opening of price proposals, the time, date and place being indicated.

### 1.2 Opening of Price Proposals

The price proposals including the discount proposals were opened at 11:00 AM on 10 February 2012 as indicated in the invitation letter, at the meeting room of the Planning and Technical Services Department in the presence of representatives of the bidders.

The Bid Opening Personnel examined the original envelopes containing price proposals of the two technically responsive bidders, which were kept under the responsibility of Project Manager. The representative of respective bidders were also requested to check the condition of the envelope of their respective price proposal and asked if they had any objection.

There were no objections from bidder's representatives. The two (2) envelopes were opened. The bidder's names, the amount of bid prices and discounts, if any were announced and recorded.

The Record of Bid Opening was prepared soon after the bids were announced and a copy of the Record of the Bid Opening was forwarded to the ADB.

## 1.3 Comparison of Price Proposals & Determination of the Lowest Evaluated Bid

The arithmetically corrected bid prices including discounts and adjusted prices for compliance with the technical requirements (functional guarantees for Distribution Transformer) as per provisions of evaluation and qualification criteria were summarized with Bid Price Comparison with Price Adjustments and attached to this Report as Appendix 3. As that comparison shows, the lowest evaluated substantially responsive bid after transformer loss capitalization is that of Bidder No. 4. The evaluated bid price (after Transformer capitalization) is NPR 139,143,836.

The evaluated price of bidder No. 3 ZIEC-Tripureshwor-Janamukhi Joint Venture, Tripureshwor, Kathmandu is NPR 175,892,860 which is 26.41% higher compared to the bid price of the lowest one.

### 1.4 **Notification of Award:**

On the basis of the systematic evaluation of bids, which had been carried out in accordance with the provisions of the bidding documents, it was concluded that Bidder No. 4 had submitted the lowest evaluated substantially responsive bid. Therefore with the concurrence of ADB, the contract for the **SUPPLY**, **DELIVERY AND CONSTRUCTION OF 33 kV AND 11kV LINES** has been awarded to Bidder No. 4 TransGlobal Power Limited, Bangalore, India at the bid price of USD 442,026.00 and NPR 99, 528,356 excluding applicable Customs and VAT.
